

ENTRANCES: Main Front Entrance for **Hospital Visitors**
ASC Patients Only – the doors by the ASC

Limited Visitation 12Noon - 5PM
EFFECTIVE JULY 6

ALL VISITORS MUST WEAR A MASK COVERING THEIR NOSE AND MOUTH.

COMING: Visitors are to enter and exit through the **Main Front Entrance** only **12noon - 5:00pm**
Visitors are to enter and exit through the **Emergency Room Entrance** only **12noon - 5:00pm** on **weekends**.

Emergency Room – If patient comes to Emergency Room, a visitor **CANNOT** come in with them. If patient is **ADMITTED**, visitor may come **12noon - 5PM**.

LEAVING: Visitors should be encouraged **NOT to leave the facility** – as they cannot reenter. **Call extension 1251** and **Notify Front Door Staff if you send visitors out for any reason** – the staff will not know if they are not told.

FOOD: If food is brought in for a **Visitor staying with a patient**, it is to be **left at the Main Front Entrance** and the **Visitor**, wearing a mask, can go down and get it.

INHOUSE PATIENT

3rd and 4th floor – 1 Visitor

- Visitors must be 18 years of age
- Visitors must be **screened before** entering the facility
- Visitors must wear a **mask** when going to patient's room and again when leaving the facility
- Visitors must wear their **wrist band** at all times (bands will include: **date and room number**)
- Visitors, **CANNOT** leave the room for any reason once they have entered, unless they are leaving the facility.

LDRP, Nursery/NICU – 1 Consistent Caregiver allowed for an ADMITTED patient

- Caregiver - **AFTER** it is determined that the mother will be admitted.
- Caregiver must be **screened before** entering the facility
- Caregiver must **wear a mask** when going to patient's room and again when leaving the facility
- Caregiver must wear their **wrist band** at all times (bands will include: **date and room number**)
- Caregiver, may leave the room to go out to the waiting area to the snack machines and such. If they leave the facility, they will not be allowed back in.
- Caregiver should be prepared to stay the entire visit **NO SWITCHING OUT**
- Caregiver should have all necessary items to shelter in place in the patient's room until discharge

Surgery – 1 Visitor while Family Member is in surgery

- Visitors must be **screened before** entering the facility – through the Main Front Entrance area
- Visitors must **wear a mask** (bring their own)
- Visitors must **wear their visitor stickers** at all times (which are provided at check-in)
- Visitors can wait in waiting room – they must sit **6ft apart** (**check your waiting area and be sure it is set up for social distancing: signs, chairs marked etc.**)
